HONG KONG MARITIME MUSEUM & CITY GALLERY VISIT

As part of our next Unit of Inquiry ‘Where We Are in Place and Time’, the Year 3 children will be going on a trip to the Hong Kong Maritime Museum. They will have the opportunity to look at the exhibits in the museum to help them find out how a very important part of Hong Kong’s history has changed, why it changed and what the effects of the change have been. After lunch in the new Tamar Park, we will then walk to visit the City Gallery to look at how Hong Kong has changed to cope with the increasing population and also investigate what plans the government have in place for the future.
