Y5 P.S.P.E & Trip to Science Museum

In the past few weeks, in our Unit of Inquiry, we have been focusing on physical and chemical changes that different materials/ substances undergo when heated or cooled.

At this age, some students in Year 5 would have started noticing certain changes happening to them too, as they make the transition from child to adolescent.

Next week, Year 5 will have two lessons on Puberty as part of the PSPE programme, covering the following topics:

- Key physical and emotional changes
- The importance of good hygiene practices
